# Where we are within the PNG Investment Regime



- ➤IPA is the first point of call for anyone intending to do business in PNG.
- ➤ We facilitate business/investment interests and we will link you up with the relevant regulatory agencies for appropriate licenses and certificates.
- >We provide options on the available investment opportunities in PNG.
- ➤ We admit FDIs and register business in PNG.
- ➤ We advocate on good policies that address EODB agenda.







- ➤ In 2009 the IPA started working with IFC/World Bank in the *Papua New Guinea Regulatory Simplification and Investment Promotion Policy Project* (the "PNGRSIPP Project") which led to the registry system going online in 2013.
- ➤ Since then the IPA has been continuously reviewing its laws, systems and processes to further simplify its processes. This has led to an improvement in PNG's EODB ranking.
- ➤ So far the IPA has reviewed the following legislations to make its processes clearer and more simpler;
- Investment Promotion (Amendment) Act 2023
- Companies (Amendment) Act 2022
- Business Groups (Amendment) Act 2022
- Associations Incorporation Act 2023
- Business Names Act 2021
- ➤ IPA involvement in the National Task Force for the AMLCTF.
- ➤ The above amendments have increased the rating of PNG in various international benchmarking surveys.





# OTHER GOVERNMENT INTERVENTIONS IN THE INVESTMENT ENVIRONMENT IMPROVEMENTS


- ➤ Digital Government Plan 2023- 2027 by the Department of Information and Communication Technology which aims to develop a single window National eGovernment Portal for citizens to have access to common public information and services.
- ➤ The transfer of labour permits to National Immigration and Citizenship Services to provide a one stop for visa and work permits for foreign businessmen.
- ➤ The e-filing of tax applications by the International Revenue Commission.




### **PNG Investment Trend**







#### Proposed FDI Values (Million Kina) by Sector as at June 2023






## Trends of transitional updates in the registry per our compliance efforts.
